2. To arrange and carry out, with support, Road Safety activities/ competitions/ surveys/ role plays etc. using information sent to you by the Casualty Reduction team or researched by yourselves.
3. To organise School assemblies, lessons and displays at school events based on a Road Safety theme at least once per term, with support and guidance from teachers.
4. To ensure that reasonable care is taken at all times for your own and others health, safety and welfare.
